 Wi-Fi 6E. Wi-Fi 7 is the next future generation of Wi-Fi that builds upon the foundational 6 GHz superhighway. In this
 session, David Coleman, director of wireless networking in the Office of the CTO at Extreme, will provide an assessment
 and technical preview of potential Wi-Fi 7 enhancements, including multi-link operation (MLO) and 4K QAM modulation.
- Securing Your Infinite Enterprise Architecture

As networks evolve and enterprises embrace the cloud, change introduces the opportunity for threat actors to exploit new vulnerabilities. In this session, learn how Extreme's layered security approach can help your organization protect the network, users and data.
